SUBJECT: Gas Inspections – New Homes

SaskPower Gas Inspections is seeking to resolve the issue of gas inspections being done after the homeowner of a new home has taken occupancy, which has created problems for the homeowners, the Builders, the Mechanical Contractors, and SaskPower Gas Inspections when deficiencies are identified.

SaskPower Gas Inspections is asking Mechanical Contractors and Builders to ensure Gas Inspectors are contacted to complete the gas inspections before the new homeowner takes occupancy.

SaskPower Gas Inspections is asking the Mechanical Contractors to contact the Gas Inspector in their area and set up appointments. Such appointments will be given priority and SaskPower Gas Inspections will make every effort to inspect gas installations on the property within 48 hours of the request.

This process will also ensure that the gas installations in new homes are inspected and are free of a defect, which in turn enhances the public safety and develops a positive image of Mechanical Contractors as well, as Home Builders.
