MINIMUM BILL

The basic monthly charge plus the demand charge.

RECORDED DEMAND

- The monthly recorded demand is the greater of the maximum kilovolt ampere (kVA) demand registered between the hours of 07:00 to 22:00, Monday through Friday, excluding statutory holidays, OR
- 75 per cent of the maximum kVA demand registered at any other time during the current month.

BILLING DEMAND

The monthly billing demand is the monthly recorded demand, but the billing demand shall not be less than 60 per cent of the maximum billing demand in the preceding 11 months.
