

NEW SERVICE CONNECTIONS

If you need new oil field services or to update existing services, we can help.

Apply for new power services or make changes to existing service online or by phone. It's quick and easy!

Here are the steps to apply:

1. Apply

We'll need a plat plan (pdf format) for each location included in your application. This is used to determine the routing and design for your service.

If there's a Lease Agreement with the landowner, please comment as to whether the agreement allows overhead and/or underground services.

Once we get your request, you'll get a notification number. Be sure to keep it handy for a reference.

2. Field Check (1-7 days)

We'll come check the site and determine the details of your request. We'll cover:

- routing
- transformer location
- work to do
- other concerns you have

3. Design (7-14 days)

We may ask you for more details to better understand your request. Once we're done with the design, we'll have you review it as part of the written quote.

After you've approved it, changes made to the design may result in extra charges. It'll also change the construction schedule.

4. Written Quote (2 days)

You'll get a written quote along with all the paperwork you'll need to sign. To stay on schedule, please sign and get them back as soon as you can.

5. Confirmation

You have 60 days to confirm the quotes.

We need confirmation in writing as well as any down payment that's stated. We'll also need you to confirm the timeline and the date your site will be ready for construction. To stay on schedule, please contact your electrician for the electrical permit early in the process.

6. Approvals (10-30+ days)

Before we start, we need to secure land approvals. We'll work with municipalities, third parties and, other utility services. We do everything we can to secure land approvals, but we cannot guarantee anything. All approvals must be in place before construction.

7. Construction (10-30+ days)

We're ready to get to work!

We've called Sask 1st Call, received material and scheduled the crew. When we're done, you'll get an invoice for the construction chargers.

8. Connection (2 days)

You'll need to contact an electrician. They'll do an inspection and place the energization sticker where necessary. Once you're done this, contact us and we'll come install a power meter.
