

Eligibility Requirements

Shand Greenhouse Seedling Application

Tree and shrub seedlings are provided free-of-charge to Saskatchewan not-for-profit organizations, service clubs, conservation groups and individual landowners. The principal requirement is a commitment to preserve and enhance Saskatchewan's environment.

Seedlings are supplied to eligible individuals and groups for the following purposes:

- Land conservation, reclamation, phytoremediation, shelterbelts, and the creation of new habitat for wildlife;
- The afforestation of portions of Saskatchewan in order to assist in the mitigation of carbon dioxide emissions; and
- Promotional events that expand the awareness and understanding of the importance of trees to our environment and that display credit to SaskPower (availability determined by Shand Greenhouse).

All qualifying projects will be planted on land holdings no less than 10 acres (4.04 ha).

Projects will not qualify if the intent is to provide:

- Landscaping for aesthetics, adjacent to dwellings or businesses;
- Profit or gain from the re-sale of plants or the sale of plant products;
- A planting as required by law, or to mitigate issues identified in an environmental impact assessment.

Applications will be accepted starting Aug. 1 or the next business day at 9 a.m. for consideration by Shand Greenhouse for spring delivery. Applications will be accepted until seedling supply runs out or Feb. 1 whichever occurs first.

Seedlings will be allocated upon review of each individual application and processed on a date-received basis. All applications are subject to approval based on the stated requirements. Shand Greenhouse reserves the right to restrict the number and types of seedlings allocated to projects. Planting projects are subject to inspection. Service may be declined at the discretion of SaskPower/Shand Greenhouse.
