
Dear Mr. Wirth:

Thank you for your email requesting a temporary delay in proceedings or decisions regarding SaskPower's Capacity Reservation Service (CRS) rate structure. SaskPower understands that current market conditions and COVID-19 preparedness has made it difficult for SIECA membership to dedicate time to the consultation process for the CRS rate structure.
