
## **Electrical Inspections**

## **Solar Installation**



- **Note**: 1. All the required labels and diagrams <u>must</u> be installed <u>before</u> the installation will be approved. All labels and diagrams installed outdoors and exposed to the weather shall meet the requirements listed in the Saskatchewan Interpretations under <u>Rules 64-072</u>, 64-074, & 64-200 for marking, warning labels, notices and diagrams.
  - 2. All wiring must be done by a licensed Saskatchewan Electrical Contractor and be covered by an appropriate electrical permit. Homeowner Permits are not allowed.
  - 3. It is the responsibility of the Electrical Contractor to arrange for an inspection <u>2 weeks</u> prior to requesting a network service connection.
  - 4. When Network Metering is installed, the Local Utility must approve all connection diagrams **before** the installation begins.
  - 5. All renewable energy installations require electrical construction plans to be submitted to Electrical Inspections and reviewed before approval will be granted. See Rule 2-014.
